C I R C U L A R

Sub: Storage tariff of the warehouses of OSWC w.e.f. 01.04.2024.

The storage tariff of different commodities on bag basis fixed for the year 2023-24 is kept unchanged. Tariff for utilization of space on area basis is revised from 01.04.2024.

02. The storage tariff will be applicable to the stock of all depositors stored either on reservation basis or occupancy basis except the stock of Food Corporation of India and OSCSC Ltd. In case of FCI, the storage tariff is regulated by the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Govt. of India and the storage tariff of OSCSC Ltd. is fixed at par with FCI.

03. The storage tariff of fertilizer stock is Rs.85/-per MT per month on reservation basis and Rs.90/- per MT per month on occupancy basis/ over and above reservation excluding GST and insurance charges as fixed for the year 2023-24.

04. The storage tariff for utilization of space on area basis in the warehouse at **Bhubaneswar** is fixed at a higher rate than other warehouses as mentioned in the Tariff Schedule.

05. In case the revised rates are not acceptable to any depositor, the depositor can dehire the reserved space after liquidation of stock within one month of the date from which revised rates come into force. In that case, the pre-revised rate shall be applicable during the grace period of one month.

06. Fumigable stock i.e. foodgrains, pulses, seeds etc. should be stored on bag basis only and not on area basis except wherever circumstances warrant with the prior approval of Corporate Office.

07. The storage charges for items which are not included in the schedule may be obtained by the Warehouse Incharges from the Corporate office, OSWC on application giving details of commodities such as weight of unit, dimension of package, possible stack heights and the value of goods.

08. The insurance charge of stock is to be claimed separately @ **Rs.0.50 per 1000 rupee value of stock per month** where the tariff is exclusive of insurance charges.

09. Goods & Service Tax/any other tax as levied by the Central/State Govt. or local bodies, if any, will be charged extra if applicable, in addition to storage, insurance & weighment charges etc.

10. The existing rebate of 10% to Co-operatives/ Agri Start-ups and 30% to bonafide farmers will be allowed. The cooperative organizations will be allowed the rebate on submission of certificate of registration as a cooperative organization. The rebate to farmers will be admissible only for the storage of their produce, raised by themselves on their land. To avail such rebate on storage charges, the farmers will have to produce the authenticated document obtained from concerned Govt. Authority as a proof of their land holding and production quantity. Rebate on account of bulk storage, longer term storage and other special circumstances shall be decided on case – to- case basis.

11. No rebate shall be allowed to other depositors without approval of the Corporate Office.

12. The Warehouse Incharges are advised to intimate the depositors about the revised schedule of storage charges for utilization of space on area basis w.e.f. 01.04.2024 and ensure implementation of revised storage tariff in the warehouses.

13. The general terms and conditions of storage and schedule of storage tariff are enclosed for strict compliance.

GENERAL CONDITION OF STORAGE AND RESERVATION

01. The tariff for storage of stock in the warehouse for the days less than one month shall be charged on the basis of actual numbers of day's utilization i.e. for example – if any depositor utilizes space for 20 days, then storage charges will be calculated as under.

Storage charges =

$$\frac{\text{Area utilized or Number of Bags} \times \text{Monthly Storage Tariff}}{\text{Number of days in calendar month}} \times \text{Number of days utilized (20)}$$

For the purpose of calculating no. of days in respect of stock under storage, both the date of receipt and date of delivery are to be included while calculating the storage charges.

02. The initial period of storage of the commodities is for three months which must be written on each and every warehouse receipt by the Superintendent at the time of receipt of stock. In case of private depositors/agencies, no extension can be given by the Warehouse Superintendent at his level after the initial valid period of storage is expired. In case such extension of storage period is necessary, the Superintendent concerned will refer to head office indicating condition of stock with a request letter of the private depositor. On receipt of permission from the head office period of storage can be extended by collecting the storage charges in full for the initial period.

03. If a depositor neither pays the storage charges nor applies for extension of storage, the withdrawal notice should be issued to withdraw the stock forthwith, otherwise the stock shall be disposed of by following the prescribed procedures after obtaining approval from Corporate Office of the OSWC.

04. In case of stock belonging to Central/State Government, Government Undertaking, Co-operatives and private depositors the storage charges shall be realized on presentation of bills. In all cases the bills should be collected within 30(thirty) days from the date of presentation of bills.

05. The storage charges, in case of private parties/ agencies should be realized through RTGS/NEFT on monthly basis and in case of any pending dues, the amounts should be collected before final delivery of stock.

06. No loose jute bales should be accepted for storage in the warehouse without prior approval from the head office.



07. The storage charge due from the depositors are to be converted to the nearest rupee to simplify the accounting and avoid the use of small coins (Fraction of rupee upto 49 paise will be neglected and 50 paise and more will be rounded to the next higher rupee).
08. In case of deposits which are not in uniform packages and it is difficult for proper stacking, the storage space should be provided on area basis on rates provided in the schedule.
09. In order to ensure availability of storage space, the depositor should reserve the storage space for a minimum period of 3(three) months. No reservation can be surrendered within the initial reservation period of three months. Where the reservation period has exceeded the initial period of 3 months, the depositor can surrender extended reservation period by giving one month notice.
10. The storage charges will be payable by the depositor for the space reserved at the prescribed rates irrespective of the fact whether the space is utilized during the period of reservation or not.
11. The infested stock normally should not be accepted in the warehouse. But in special circumstances under pressure of the depositor, if the infested stock has to be accepted in the warehouse, the stock should be fumigated immediately and it should be recorded clearly that the stock is infested one and for which a declaration from the depositor should be obtained. In this case, the initial fumigation charges should be realized from the depositor @ Rs.16/- per MT. The Warehouse Receipt should contain the nature of infestation etc. at the time of deposit.
12. The moisture content of commodities, quality of goods should be properly examined at the time of acceptance of commodities and the same should be mentioned in the "Application Form for Deposit of Goods" properly so that no complications would arise at the time of realization of storage charges. The signature of the depositor should be recorded in the moisture content register to avoid future complication.
13. The prescribed limit of stack heights should be strictly followed. In no case storage of stock beyond the permissible height is allowed.
14. In case of utilization of godowns of OSWC by the depositors for storage of stock in their own custody, insurance and safe storage of stock are to be undertaken by them. Commodities other than that approved by the OSWC at the time of letting out of godown will not be accepted for storage.


- i. Commodities deposited in bulk, agricultural implements, iron and steel materials i.e. pipes, sheets etc. paper and other such goods which do not have a uniform package or received without packaging shall be accepted for storage on area rates subject to load bearing capacity of the floor of 0.33 MT to a sqft.. (3.55 MT to a sq. mtr.)
- ii. In case package of different dimensions and weight occupying more storage space/ having higher bag equivalent are in storage or are received for storage the rates indicated in this tariff would not be applicable. In such cases proforma details should be furnished to the Corporate Office for fixation of storage charges.
- iii. The storage tariff does not include handling, transportation and other incidental charges.


